The sculpture to San Pedro Claver is located on the corner of the Plaza de San Pedro Claver, in the historic center of Cartagena de Indias- Colombia. San Pedro Claver is considered one of the first defenders of human rights in Latin America, He dedicated his life to the good treatment and defense of the black slaves brought from Africa until the end of his days.
